- 1. All junior golfers will play to the 2015 USGA Rules of Golf and all local rules. A player is responsible for the score of his/her competitors. He/she is responsible to watch all strokes. HONESTY IS EXPECTED AT ALL TIMES. ALL SCORES MUST BE COMPLETE AND ACCURATE.
- 2. The player must register with the starter immediately upon arrival at the tournament site.
- 3. Proper golf attire is required at all times. Blue jeans, cut-off shorts, tank tops, and tee shirts will not be allowed. Golf shoes (soft spikes required) or sneakers are required.
- 4. UNSPORTMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. LOUD AND/OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE, CHEATING AND/OR THROWING CLUBS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME.
- 5. All players must respect the course by raking traps, fixing ball marks, and replacing divots where applicable. Trash should be place in the proper receptacles.
- 6. Caddies and/or motorized carts are not permitted.
- 7. Completion of all rounds is mandatory. In the event of an illness and/or injury Mr. Dougherty must be notified immediately.
- 8. Girls may compete with the boys by playing the same tees and in the proper age group.
- 9. All players are responsible for a correct and signed scorecard that must contain the player's and his/her marker's signature. Players are required to wait at the leaderboard until their score has been posted.
- 10. Spectators and parents may not give advice or walk directly with players. The 2015 USGA Rules of Golf rule #8 clearly defines "advice" and must adhered to by all players, spectators and parents. Parents may observe from a distance, but may not keep score or interpret the rules. Any violation of this rule will result in a player disqualification and suspension from the next tournament.
- 11. Players may spectate after the completion of their round, but are not permitted to walk with or to disturb other players.
- 12. A player who is eligible for a prize must wait near the scoring area until prizes are distributed.
- 13. Any Player or Parent who does not follow the above rules will be disqualified and/or suspended from Play for either the next event or the remainder of the season.
